DEFINITION: To perform a variety of skilled mechanical repairs, installations, overhaul, and specialized work in servicing, maintaining and rebuilding a variety of mechanical equipment and facilities; to operate power-driven trucks, tools and equipment. Performs general cleaning and janitorial work and other various job assignments associated with plant operation and upkeep. Reports to and accepts assignments from the Division Manager or his designee. Works independently or with other Wastewater personnel. Required to be available for emergency overtime.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Assist Maintenance C and B personnel in the performance of their duties, according to the instructions given. Maintain, repair and rebuild chlorination and de-chlorination equipment, including the chlorinator, feed lines and effluent pump as required. Assist in the loading and unloading of chlorine and sulfur dioxide ton containers. Replace empty on-line containers with full containers and install "pig-tails" from container to manifold as required. Observe all chlorine and sulfur dioxide safety rules and procedures. Maintain, repair and rebuild all pumps and equipment associated with the digester system. Assist in the operation of sludge transfers and in the pumping of sludge to the Bio solids Facility when necessary. Maintain, repair and rebuild all mechanism associated with the primary treatment system, including raw sludge pumps, chains, sprockets, motors, guide rails, shoes, shafts and flights, etc. Maintain, repair and rebuild all mechanisms associated with the secondary treatment system, including the collector tracks, tanks, motors, gear boxes, wheels and pumps, aeration diffusers and tubes, etc. Maintain, repair and rebuild all mechanism associated with the grit removal system, including chains, sprockets, motors, guide rails, buckets, shoes, shafts, auger system, etc. Inspect, maintain, repair, adjust and rebuild all water, sewage, sludge and chemical pumps used in the wastewater treatment system. Maintain, repair, rebuild, overhaul and adjust all equipment and mechanisms associated with the plant's internal combustion engines and blowers, involving the engines themselves, and all related air compressor equipment, the water cooling system and all associated pumps and blenders, engine carburetion and ignition, air filtration and lubrication, etc. Maintain and repair all piping and fitting associated with the wastewater treatment system. Maintain, repair, and rebuild all mechanisms and equipment associated with the plant's lift stations. Monitor the condition and operation of the plant's Bio solids Facility and performs related maintenance as required. Operate heavy equipment used to condition sludge for final removal.
