JOB TITLE -Golf Course Crew Member 2

DEFINITION: Seasonal golf course maintenance worker. Receives direction from and reports to Golf Course Superintendent & Assistant Golf Course Superintendent. Employees will carry out the daily mowing and setup tasks which are vital to course operations.

- Flexible schedule required, will work early mornings on weekdays, weekends, and holidays.
- Work week will be 25-37.5 hours.

- Changing hole locations
- String trimming
