



## QUICK GUIDE TO INCENTIVES FOR HISTORIC PROPERTY OWNERS

## For Residential Historic Properties

Residential Historic Rehabilitation Tax Credit-

- o For Qualified, Owner-Occupied, Residential Buildings
- o Must be Listed on the Indiana Register of Historic Sites and Structures
- o Preservation or Rehabilitation Exceeding \$10,000
- o Up to 20% State Income Tax credit for Qualified Expenses

## For Commercial Historic Properties

Federal Historic Rehabilitation Investment Tax Credit-

- o For Qualified, Income-Producing Buildings
- o Must be Listed on the National Register
- o 20% Income Tax Credit on Qualified Rehabilitation Expenses

## Historic Renovation Grant Program-

- o For Qualified, Income-Producing Buildings (or Non-Profit)
- o Exterior Preservation or Rehabilitation Activities
- Property Must be at Least 50 Years Old and Listed or Eligible to be Listed on the National or Indiana Register
- o Competitive Grant Requests Between \$5,000 and \$100,000
- Requires Local Match of 50%
