JOB TITLE -Golf Maintenance Specialist

DEFINITION: Seasonal golf course maintenance worker. Receives direction from and reports to Golf Course Superintendent & Assistant Golf Course Superintendent. Employees will carry out daily mowing and maintenance to the golf turf as well as repair and maintenance of building structures and course hardware.

- Flexible schedule required, will work early mornings, weekends, and holidays.
- Work week will be 35-37.5 hours

EQUIPMENT USED: All equipment used to perform golf course maintenance.

- 3. Turf aerators
- 4. Large area mowers
- 5. Power tools and measuring devices
- 6. Mini dump truck
- 7. Fertilizer spreader
- 8. Seeders
- 9. Turf roller

JOB LOCATION: 95% of the duties will be performed at Eberhart-Petro Golf Course.

ENVIRONMENTAL/WORKING CONDITIONS: 95% of the work will be performed outside in all types of weather conditions

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE JOB: Perform high level maintenance functions necessary to golf course operation.

EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED:

- 1. Aerating and topdressing
- 2. Mowing greens, tees, fairways, and rough
- 3. Leaf blowing
- 4. Fertilizing and weed control
- 5. Cutting wood
- 6. Irrigation repair
