




## Mishawaka Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Locations

There are 16 locations in Mishawaka's sewer system where a combination of sewage and stormwater can overflow into the St. Joseph River, as shown on the map below. In an average year, these overflows can occur up to 51 times from one or more overflow locations.

Progress has already been made to reduce overflows. Since 1990, the city has spent \$300 million on wastewater treatment plant improvements and sewer separation projects, which have reduced sewer overflows from an estimated 314 million gallons to 2.7 million gallons annually. The city's long-term control plan will reduce overflows even more.
